Entries close September 25 at 4:00 p.m.
 Stalls will be assigned by the Directors in Charge
Enclose \$25.00 for each Exhibitor's Ticket required.
Exhibitors will furnish their own feed and bedding.

Dairy Cattle: No dairy bulls born before September 1st of the previous year may be shown. Every female over 24 months must have produced a living calf within the past 12 months or prove to be with calf. Any heifer born twin to a bull must be proven to have a reproductive tract before being eligible to be shown. Proof may be provided by palpation or a blood test conducted by a licensed veterinarian prior to the fair. No animal which is not entered and shown in individual classes will be eligible to be shown in group classes. **For Arrival and Release Times, see Page 12, No. 31.**

All exhibitors will be limited to not more than two entries in any one class. All animals, regardless of age, must be recorded and appear in the name of the exhibitor on the records of their respective associations.

All exhibitors must be prepared to show certificates, registration or qualified when called for. Failure forfeits right to show or award.

No premium will be awarded unless animal corresponds to description and ownership as shown by registration and transfer certificates.

Open Beef Breeding classes will follow the same breed qualification as Jr. Fair. Breed classes must have a minimum of 2 entries per Breed or will show in AOB division.

BEEF CATTLE CLASSIFICATION

This is a registered show. All animals must have registration papers. Enclose \$25.00 for each exhibitor ticket required & \$5.00 per head entered. Truck-in cattle welcome day of show. No Open Class stalling available - show off trailer. Photo copies of registration papers must be submitted with entry. Cattle released after show. Note on entry blank if also entered as Jr. Fair.

1. All calves must be in place by 9:00 a.m. show day.
2. All cattle released after the show.
3. Calves will be weighed at 9:00 a.m. and show by weight.
4. This is a Beef show. No Dairy breeding accepted.
5. Calves must be dropped after January 1, 2024.
6. **NEW** - Weight limit is 300 - 850 pounds.
7. Calves must be castrated. Dehorning is recommended.
8. **CALVES MUST BE BROKEN TO LEAD AND SHOW.**
9. Steers and heifers shown in separate classes.
10. Market Heifers class will be added if a minimum of 5 head entered. Otherwise, market heifers will be shown in steer classes.
11. Heifers may be "double entered" to show in market and breeding classes.
12. The beef committee reserves the right to reject any calf that does not meet the physical requirements as to size, age, quality, castration, etc.
13. Out of state cattle must present Health Certificate from Certified Veterinarian according to ODA regulations..

All cattle shown must be dehorned with the exception of calves. **The Order of Showing will be announced prior to the show.** Only straw may be used for bedding. Send \$2.00 for each stall needed. \$25.00 is required for each Exhibitor’s Ticket. For out of county please call the office to inquire about additional admission tickets. Lactating Dairy Cows (both Open and Junior) have the option to arrive before 9:00 a.m. Tuesday or after 8 p.m. Tuesday evening. All one day lactating show cattle (both in-county & out-of-county) must be in place on fairgrounds by 9:00 a.m. Wednesday, release after show is complete on Wednesday. Arrival time and release time for out-of-county heifers and calves will coincide with the lactating cattle. Arrival time for in-county heifers and calves will be either Friday after 8:00 p.m. or before Saturday 11:00 a.m. or after 4:30 p.m. Saturday.
