- 1 cup all-purpose flour1/3 cup unsweetened cocoa powder
- 2. 1/4 teaspoon salt
- 3. 1/2 cup butter, softened
- 2/3 cup granulated sugar
- 1 large egg, separated
- 2 tablespoons milk
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 8. 1 cup pecans, finely chopped
- 2/3 cup Kraft caramel bits or regular caramels
- 10.1/2 teaspoon water

- Preheat oven to 350°F and line a baking sheet with parchment paper
- In a bowl, combine flour, cocoa powder, and salt

- Roll chilled dough into small balls, dip each in egg white, then roll in chopped pecans
- 9. Place balls on prepared baking sheet and press a small indentation in the center of each
- 10. Bake for 10 to 12 minutes until set
- 11. Remove from oven and gently press indentations again if needed
- 12. In a microwave-safe bowl, combine caramel bits and water
- 13. Microwave in 30-second intervals, stirring after each, until smooth
- 14. Spoon melted caramel into the indentations of each cookie
- 15. Optional: drizzle with melted chocolate or sprinkle with sea salt
- Let cookies cool completely before serving
