



2026 FAIRFIELD COUNTY FAIR CAMPING

*Camping is available during the fair for a fee of \$400 per unit. No gate admissions are included in this fee. If interested in a campsite, please submit the online application by the designated deadline. (March 1st-31st for current site holders, April 1st-30th for new campers) All applications will be reviewed, and camp site assignments will be made by the Fairfield County Agricultural Society Camping Committee. Once approved and notified by the Camping Committee of site assignment, approved campers will have until June 30th to submit their Campsite Agreement acknowledging the rules below and full payment must accompany this agreement. Checks can be written to the **Fairfield County Ag Society (FCAS)**.*

Rental of a campsite for the fair includes up to sixteen days. The camping period for the fair begins as early as October 3rd, 2026 through October 18th, 2026. At this time, electricity will be disconnected from the camping unit.

CAMPING RULES

1. Camping units **MUST** fit within the marked lot boundaries. Camping unit length includes the bumper and hitch and anything attached to it.
2. You must be 18 years of age or older to reserve a campsite in your name.
3. All camping units on site must be covered by a valid and current insurance policy, and proof of coverage must be shown before permits will be released.
4. Adult supervision is required for anyone under the age of 18 staying in the camping unit. An 11:30pm curfew will be enforced.
5. Camping permits assigned by the administrative office must be picked up and displayed in a place on the unit that is visible from the roadway at all times and before the camping unit is placed.
6. Camping agreements are non-transferable to anyone not listed on the agreement other than a surviving spouse, should death occur. In the event of divorce, only the person listed in the agreement is entitled to the site the following year.



7. No subleasing of campsites is permitted. The FCAS reserves the right to terminate any contract at any time if you are caught subleasing.
8. No waste of any kind is to be dumped at any time in the camping areas. Waste disposal services are available at the camper's expense during fair week to pump sewage tanks. All campers must have a container for grey water. Any signs of dumping will be cause for immediate removal and forfeiture of camping privileges.

9. Health and fire codes must be respected and observed. This means absolutely NO OPEN FLAMES including grills (gas or otherwise)
10. Campsites must be kept in an orderly condition. No alcoholic beverages are permitted within public view. Illegal drugs will not be tolerated.
11. Absolutely NO VEHICLES are to be parked at any camper.
12. Unauthorized private/personal golf carts, ATVs, or UTVs are strictly prohibited from the grounds. If a camper is found to have any of these, it may result in forfeiture of camping privileges.
13. Awnings are not permitted to be open. Only one 12x12 or smaller tent or canopy per site is permitted and MUST fit within the marked boundaries of your camping spot.
14. No dogs or pets are permitted in or on the grounds during the week of the fair.
15. No political signs are to be displayed at or on camping units. This includes signs and/or flags.

Failure to comply with the above stated rules will result in forfeiture of camping privileges and removal of the camper from the fairgrounds without a refund. The Fairfield County Agricultural Society reserves the right to cancel a lot contract at any time and refuse or reject any application for camping. All decisions made by the FCAS Camping Committee are final. Campers further agree not to hold the Fairfield County Agricultural Society responsible for any damage or accidents of any sort.
